DaRTS is a data and report tracking system that BLaST Intermediate Unit #17 has developed originally for our own use, but has become a successful tool for December Child Count, Revised Count and PIMS Reporting. Numerous districts and Intermediate Units are currently using Darts across the state of Pennsylvania. It is expressly designed for Special Educators and others who work with IEPs as well as other specialized student tracking.
